Qualification for Application

A. Basic Qualification

- ① Overseas Korean: Applicants must have completed both primary and secondary education outside Korea and must have completed a undergraduate program either in Korea or elsewhere.
- ② Foreigner Type I: Applicants and their both parents must be citizens other than Korea.
- ⑤ Foreigner Type II: Applicants must have completed primary, secondary and undergraduate education outside.
- NOTE: Applicants who hold dual nationality are not eligible to apply as foreign students. But can apply through general admission.

B. Language Qualification

Applicants must satisfy at least one of the criteria listed below.

- ① TOPIK or KLAT Level 3 or higher
- ②TOEFL(PBT550, CBT 210, iBT 80), IELTS 5.5, TEPS 550 or higher or equivalent by a state-authorized certificate
- ③Applicants who are not belong to ① and② must pass the Korean language proficiency exam held by the Korean Language Institute of GNU before graduation. Language ability must be equivalent to TOPIK Level 4.

④ Applicants in the Department of Business Administration and International Trade must meet the requirements listed below :

 - * The foreign student who is keeping a E1 ~ E7 working visa is ruled out.
- C. TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) Scholarship
- Eligibility: TOPIK or KLAT(Korean Language Ability Test) Certificates of level 4 or higher
- The amount of scholarship and method of its selection

- If get Level 4 during enrollment period: support admission fee and class fee.
- If get Level 5 or 6 during enrollment period: support half amount of class fee 2(school-supporting association fee)

- Degrees and transcripts from Chinese universities
- e. ~ f. ① Education documents confirmed by a Korean Consul in the country of residence or foreign missions in Korea ②China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center, or Refer to the website http://www.cdgdc.edu.cn choose one from the two options
- g. Certificate of parent-child relationship (亲属关系公证) indicating nationality: must be accompanied by Korean Embassy's Confirmation in Korean or English.
- h. A copy of the applicant's colored passport
- i. Financial statement. Applicants must submit one of these below. In the case of Chinese students, please submit ① for the visa application.
 - A certificate of bank statement amounting to or exceeding US\$12,000 deposited for more than three months in the name of the applicant or parents or,
 - ② A certificate of bank statement amounting to or exceeding US\$12,000 deposited in the name of Korean guarantor or,
 - A certificate of scholarship must indicate financial support and duration of scholarship
- j. Two photographs (3.5cm x 4.5cm with white background)
 - A photo attached to an application form

- Enclose a photo with applicant's name on its back
- k. Certificate of Language Proficiency test refers to the 'Language Qualification'
- Korean language scholarship will be awarded to holders of TOPIK or KLAT level 4 or higher.
- Documents (c), (d), (e) and (i) can be exempted for students who received their degree(s) at GNU.
- L. An application fee of 70,000 Korean won
